



Send a Message:

Post seeds to a Member of the European Parliament (MEP) to motivate them to work for a EU seed law that promotes diversity and the right to seed!

In the past two years, we have been working with seed initiatives across Europe for a better EU seed law. **The current proposal massively threatens the conservation and circulation of cultivated plant diversity.** It disregards the right of farmers under international law to harvest, use, exchange and sell their own seeds. This is unacceptable! Our petition "Raise our Forks!" with over 100,000 supporters so far from all over Europe shows that cultivated plant diversity is not a niche issue.

On April 24, the plenary session of the European Parliament will vote on the proposed new EU seed law, which will apply in future in all member states. **Take part in our seed campaign!** Help us to get our message across to the MEPs with the most valuable thing that we have for the future of our food – our seeds!

How to take part in our seed campaign:

1. Cut out the template and assemble the envelope.
2. Add vegetable, herb or cereal seeds of open-pollinated varieties. If you don't have any seeds, ask your family, friends, or farmers in the neighbourhood.
3. Write the name of the species (e.g. "lettuce") and a variety name on the envelope.
4. Add your name and e-mail address. This shows that you are serious and and you believe in your seeds.
5. Pick an MEP and enter their name and office number in the address box. We recommend you send them to MEPs highlighted in colour in the list.
6. Seal the envelope, stamp it and post it by the 15th of April.
